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**Notes:**

“Tracks” are simply to help sort the content by areas of interest. Sessions from all tracks will count toward licensure and certification for both AUDs and SLPs, so feel free to attend sessions outside your usual practice niche.

\* “Level” means “Instructional Level”

**I = Introductory** – Assumes little or no information about the topic.

The focus is on general **orientation** and increased **awareness** of the participant.

**II = Intermediate** – Assumes a general familiarity with the literature and professional practice within the area covered.

The focus is on increased **understanding** and **application** by the participant.

**III = Advanced** – Assumes thorough familiarity with the current literature and professional practice.

The focus is on **recent advances and application of research**.
