



If you are a speech-language pathologist or audiologist licensed in Florida, ASHA has good news for you!

The American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (**ASHA**) is working in partnership with **CE Broker**, the electronic continuing education tracking system for Florida, to transfer all ASHA CEUs earned from 1/1/04 forward. If you have earned, or plan to earn, ASHA CEUs from any of the 460 ASHA Approved CE Providers, follow the directions below to give ASHA your **Florida license number**.

ASHA members/certificate holders:

Call the Action Center (**800-498-2071**), or go to www.asha.org and:

1. Click on “**My Account**” (above the ASHA header at the top of the page).
2. Log in by entering your **e-mail address** and **password**.
3. Click on the heading “**Manage Your Florida State Licensure Information.**” Add your Florida SLP and/or AUD license number. You may update this information at any time.

Note: If you have not yet registered with the ASHA Web site, go to <http://asha.org/register.htm> and enter your 8-digit ASHA account number (located on your ASHA membership card, invoices, and most correspondence from ASHA) and last name. Follow the prompts to complete registration. Then follow the three steps above to enter your Florida license number.

NSSLHA members: Same as above, but use your 8-digit NSSLHA account number.

Nonmembers: If you use the ASHA CE Registry, but are not an ASHA member or certificate holder, call the Action Center (**800-498-2071**) to obtain your ASHA account number or to simply provide your Florida license number.
